Now and for ever and ever. Amen.

<u>Theotokion, tone 2</u>: The tomb and death could not hold the Mother of God [Theotókos], * unceasing in her intercession and an unfailing hope of patronage, * for as the Mother of Life she was transferred to life * by Him Who dwelt in her ever-virgin womb.

<u>Prokimenon, tone 8</u>: Their utterance has gone forth into all the earth, * and their words unto the ends of the world. (*Ps. 18:5*)

<u>Verse</u>: The heavens tell the glory of God, and the firmament declares the work of His hand. (*Ps. 18:2*)

Epistle: Colossians 4:5-9, 14, 18, pericope 260

<u>Alleluia of the Apostle, tone 1</u>: The heavens shall confess Your wonders, O Lord, and Your truth in the church of the saints. (Ps. 88:6)
