



BYZANTINE-KYÏVAN LITURGICAL CALENDAR AM 7532 / AD 2023-24

GLORY TO JESUS CHRIST! It is our pleasure to present to you the first Society of Saint John Chrysostom liturgical calendar. This conveniently lists the feasts, fasts and liturgical readings for each day of the year according to the Kyïvan recension of the Byzantine rite, as celebrated by the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church (UGCC).

In February 2023 the Holy Synod of the UGCC announced that, together with the Orthodox Church of Ukraine, it would move from the old Julian calendar to the revised Julian calendar from 1 September of that year. In essence this meant the liturgical calendar would no longer be 13 days behind the civil calendar for fixed feasts but Pascha (Easter) and its cycle of feasts and fasts would continue to be observed according to the old Julian reckoning, which can be anything from a week to a month behind the Western calculation, but also sometimes on the same date (as in 2025).

However the Eparchy of the Holy Family of London, with which we are associated, took a further step and chose to adopt the Gregorian calendar in its entirety. This presented itself as an ideal opportunity for us to produce a calendar which could serve as both a liturgical and spiritual aid to English-speaking Greek Catholics as well as an educational resource for Latin Catholics and other Western Christians with an interest in the Byzantine rite. For it is far easier to appreciate both the similarities and differences in the Roman and Byzantine calendars when, for

example, both Christmas and Pascha occur on the same days in each.

As with all Christian calendars, the Byzantine calendar follows the movements and rhythms of Creation along two concurrent cycles: lunar and solar. The former revolves around Pascha, the great feast of feasts, while the latter is bookended by the equinox and solstice of the Incarnation: the Annunciation and the Nativity, both of which have served as New Year's Day at various times and places in European history. These cycles are reflected in the two sets of readings for each day of the year: one moveable and one fixed. In some traditions it is customary to chant both sets of readings at the Divine Liturgy each day but, as this is generally done in the UGCC only for feasts ranked Class III and above, we have reflected this in our listings. Likewise, days with feasts ranked Class II and above are listed without the moveable readings of the day, owing to the dignity of the feast. And, unlike in the Roman rite, the Byzantine liturgical year begins not at Advent but on 1 September, which was New Year's Day in the Byzantine Empire from 537 to 1453.

The Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church is at once universal, patriarchal and local, and this is reflected in the variety of feasts listed in this calendar. Most great feasts of our Lord and Lady are universal and well known to Latin Catholics and Christians of other traditions. Many feasts derive from the Great Church of Constantinople from which the Metropolis of Kyïv sprang; others come

from the shared tradition of Kyïvan Rus' while some are unique to the Ukrainian Greek Catholic Church itself. In transliterating their Greek and Slavic names we have sought to strike a balance between authenticity and legibility while, for Biblical personages, the common English forms have been retained. As the Society is based in the United Kingdom, we have also sought to include saints and commemorations native to Britain and Ireland, even when these are not observed on any Byzantine rite calendar. These feasts are marked with a *Chi-Rho* Christogram which, if read as an Anglo-Saxon bind rune, can also be interpreted as 'the gift of mirth'. The months are given in English with the *Anno Domini* year and in Church Slavonic with the *Anno Mundi* year.

Finally, we must say a word about fasting, as attitudes to this ascetic practice differ markedly in the East and West. In Latin Christianity the obligation to fast has historically been minimal but penitential in nature and enforced 'on pain of sin'. In Byzantine Christianity, on the other hand, fasting is extensive and frequent but understood as an ideal towards which to strive that, in conjunction with prayer and almsgiving, helps us to conquer our passions and advance us on the path to *theosis*. So, while this calendar does provide symbols indicating the traditional Byzantine rule, it is important to note that the UGCC also has a minimum fasting rule which is very similar to that of modern Latin practice. This can be found easily online and may serve as a useful starting point for beginners. ✠
