First Antiphon

Verse 1: Shout to the Lord, all the earth, * sing now to His Name, give glory to His Praise. (Ps. 65:2)

Refrain: Through the prayers of the Mother of God [Theotókos], * O Saviour, save us.

Verse 2: The voice of Your thunder was in the whirlwind; * Your lightning lit up the world. (Ps. 76:19)

Refrain: Through the prayers of the Mother of God [Theotókos], * O Saviour, save us.

Verse 3: You have clothed Yourself in praise and splendour, * You robe Your-self in light as with a cloak. (Ps. 103:1-2)

Refrain: Through the prayers of the Mother of God [Theotókos], * O Saviour, save us.

Verse 2: And He led them to the mount of His holy place, * to this mountain which His right hand had won. (Ps. 77:54)

Refrain: Son of God, transfigured on the mount, * save us who sing to You: Alleluia.

Verse 3: Mount Sion which He loved, * He made his holy place; as steadfast as a monolith. (Ps. 77:68-69)

Refrain: Son of God, transfigured on the mount, * save us who sing to You: Alleluia.

Third Antiphon

Verse 1: Come, let us sing joyfully to the Lord, * let us acclaim God, our Saviour. (Ps. 94:1)

Refrain: Son of God, transfigured on the mount, * save us who sing to You: Alleluia.

Verse 2: Let us come before His face with praise, * and acclaim Him in psalms. (Ps. 94:2)

Refrain: Son of God, transfigured on the mount, * save us who sing to You: Alleluia.

Verse 3: For God is the great Lord (Ps. 94:3) * and the great king over all earth. (Ps. 46:2)

Refrain: Son of God, transfigured on the mount, * save us who sing to You: Alleluia.

Entrance verse: Come let us worship and fall down before Christ. (Ps. 67:2)

Refrain: Son of God, transfigured on the mount, * save us who sing to You: Alleluia.

Troparion, tone 7: You were transfigured on the mount, O Christ God, * showing Your glory to your disciples as much as they could bear. * Make Your eternal light shine * also on us who are sinners, * through the prayers of the Mother of God [Theotókos], * O Giver of Light, glory to You.

Kontakion, tone 7: You were transfigured on the mount, O Christ our God, * and Your disciples saw Your glory as much as they could; * that when they saw You crucified * they might know that you suffered willingly, * and might proclaim to the world * that You are truly the brightness of the Father.

Prokimenon of the Resurrection, tone 2: The Lord is my strength and my song of praise, * and He has become my salvation. (Ps. 117:14)

Verse: The Lord has indeed chastised me, but he has not delivered me to death. (Ps. 117:18)

Epistle: 1 Corinthians 1:3-9, pericope 123

Alleluia of the Resurrection, tone 2: The Lord will hear you in the day of tribulation; the Name of the God of Jacob will shield you. (Ps. 19:2)

Verse: Lord, grant victory to the king and hear us in the day that we shall call upon You. (Ps. 19:10)

Gospel: Matthew 19:3-12, pericope 78

Instead of It is truly meet, we chant: O my soul, magnify the Lord transfigured on the mountain.

And Hirmos, tone 4: Your giving birth was revealed as incorrupt; * for it was God who came forth from your womb; * He appeared on earth in the flesh, and made

His dwelling among us. * Thus, O Mother of God [Theotókos], all of us magnify you.

Communion Verse: We will walk in the light of Your face, O Lord, * and rejoice in Your Name forever. (Ps. 88:15-16) Alleluia. (3)

Troparion, tone 3: In confessing the Faith you proclaimed Orthodox doctrine * and were unjustly exiled for rebuking the wicked Emperor. * O righteous and glorious Emilian, * the boast of Kyzikos, * entreat Christ God to grant us His great mercy.

Troparion, tone 3: As a valiant defender of the Trinity, * the Church for which you suffered glorifies you with hymns, O Emilian, since you suffered for Her. * Therefore we honour your memory. * Deliver your servants from all assaults of the Enemy.
